

Download Mac Manual Restore Iphone

Connect your device to a computer using USB. Open iTunes on the computer. Click the iPhone button near the top of the iTunes window. In the Summary pane, click Restore iPhone. Select your iPhone, iPad, or iPod when it appears in iTunes. For an unresponsive device or one that won't turn on, learn what to do. Or get help if your device doesn't appear in iTunes. In the Summary panel, click Restore [device]. Click Restore again to confirm. Then iTunes erases your device and installs the latest iOS or iPod software. Turn on your device. You should see a Hello screen. If you already set up your device, you need to erase all of its content before you can use these steps to restore from your backup. Follow the onscreen setup steps until you reach the Apps & Data screen, then tap Restore from iCloud Backup. Sign in to iCloud with your Apple ID. Choose a backup. When updating or restoring, connect iPhone to a USB port that is built into the computer instead of the keyboard or an external USB hub. Remove all USB devices other than your mouse, keyboard, and iPhone. Use the Dock Connector to USB cable that came with iPhone. Do not use a dock or third-party cable.
