These displays can be through facial expressions, gestures and body language, volume and tone of voice, laughing, crying, etc. Affect displays can be altered or faked so one may appear one way, when they feel another (i.e. smiling when sad). Affect can be conscious or non-conscious and can be discreet or obvious. Ecological approaches (Bronfenbrenner & Morris, 2006) acknowledge that behavior does not occur in a vacuum but is affected by the larger culture and society, the local community, and its institutions.
